Minn. Stat. 10A.02, subd 11 - Violations; enforcement.

The board shall investigate any alleged violation filed in writing with the board. For an alleged violation of sections 10A.25 (expenditure limits) or 10A.27 (additional limits) the board shall either enter into a conciliation agreement or make a public finding of whether or not there is probable cause, within 60 days of the filing of the complaint. For alleged violations of all other sections, the board shall within 30 days after the filing of the complaint make a public finding of whether or not there is probable cause to believe a violation has occurred.

The deadline for action may be extended by a majority vote of the board. Within a reasonable time after beginning an investigation of an individual or association, the board shall notify that individual or association of the fact of the investigation. The board shall make no finding without notifying the individual or association of the nature of the allegations and affording an opportunity to answer those allegations.

Any hearing or action of the board concerning a complaint or investigation shall be confidential until the board makes a public finding concerning probable cause or enters into a conciliation agreement.

Except as provided in section 10A.28, after the board makes a public finding of probable cause the board shall report that finding to the appropriate law enforcement authorities.

Introduction

This complaint alleges a violation of Minnesota Statutes §10A.01 subdivision 18 by the Minnesota DFL Party, DFL Senate Caucus, DFL endorsed Minnesota Senate District 48 candidate Laurie McKendry, and the McKendry for Minnesota Senate committee and/or its agents (collectively referred to as Respondents). For a period beginning on or about September 18, 2012, through October 19, 2012 the Minnesota DFL Party disseminated campaign materials in support of the Laurie McKendry campaign. The purported independent expenditures were made with the express or implied consent, authorization, or cooperation of, or in concert with or at the request or suggestion of the DFL endorsed Senate District 48 candidate Laurie McKendry, her principal campaign committee McKendry for Minnesota Senate, and/or its agents (collectively referred to as McKendry). Respondents have violated Chapter 10A, the Campaign Finance and Public Disclosure Act by disseminating campaign materials as independent expenditures that were, in fact, not independent of Johnson.

Facts

Laurie McKendry is the DFL endorsed candidate for the Minnesota Senate in Senate District 48. For a period beginning on or about September 18, 2012, through October 19, 2012 the Minnesota DFL Party disseminated literature by U.S. Mail to influence voters to support the Laurie McKendry campaign for Minnesota Senate District 48. *See*, Exhibit A. Several photographs of Laurie McKendry appear on the literature. *See*, *Id.* The disclaimer identifies the literature as independent expenditures prepared and paid for by the Minnesota DFL Party. *See*, *Id.*

Argument

An independent expenditure requires that the expenditure be made “without the express or implied consent, authorization, or cooperation of, and not in concert with or at the request or suggestion of, any candidate or any candidate's principal campaign committee or agent.” Minnesota Statutes, §10A.01, subd. 18. The Board has emphasized that there must be a high wall of separation between the party unit and its candidates if the party unit's expenditures are to qualify as independent expenditures. *See*, Findings and Order in the Matter of the Complaint of Bob Murray regarding House District 54A Republican Party of Minnesota and Citizens for (Mark) Fotsch.

It is apparent that all of the photographs in which Laurie McKendry is a subject in the literature were taken with the active participation of Ms. McKendry. *See*, Exhibit A. Searches for photographs of Laurie McKendry, including her official campaign website, facebook, flickr, and google images, reveal that photographs used in the purported independent expenditure are not publicly available. *See*, Exhibit B, C, D, and E. The Minnesota DFL Party's use of photographs

that are unavailable to the general public is strong evidence that the expenditures were made with the express or implied consent, authorization, or cooperation of, or in concert with or at the request or suggestion of McKendry. The Minnesota DFL Party did not maintain the necessary high wall of separation from McKendry. As a result, the expenditures do not qualify as an independent expenditure and should be found to be in violation of Minnesota Statutes, §10A.01.

The criteria for independence cannot be maintained even if the photographs are remotely available. The Board has found that it does not require active approval of the expenditure by a candidate or agent to defeat the independence requirement. *See*, Findings and Order in the matter of the complaint of Arvid Dixen regarding Philip Krinkie. Even implied consent, resulting from action or inaction, can change the character of the expenditure to an approved expenditure. *See*, *Id.* In the case of the photographs of Laurie McKendry, if the photographs are publicly available they are in an obscure location, and it would require the Minnesota DFL Party or the DFL Senate Caucus to get implied consent, authorization, or cooperation of, or action in concert with or at the request or suggestion of McKendry to locate them. Therefore, even if the photographs are available in some form, approval or acquiescence, defeating independence would still be required from McKendry for the photographs to be placed in the possession of the Minnesota DFL Party.

Further evidence that the expenditures were made with the express or implied consent, authorization, or cooperation of, action in concert with or at the request or suggestion of Johnson is evidenced by the staged photographs. The DFL Senate Caucus reported spending \$547.99 on camera equipment in the month of June. *See*, Exhibit F. The DFL State Central Committee has spent \$64,669.29 on supposed independent expenditures in support of Laurie McKendry's campaign. *See*, Exhibit G. The facts suggest that a DFL Senate Caucus or DFL Party representative met with Johnson to coordinate efforts on supposed independent expenditures. The necessary high wall of separation simply cannot be maintained when representatives of the DFL Senate Caucus and the DFL State Central Committee are literally in the room with McKendry as the purported independent expenditures are being produced.

Conclusion

Photographs of Minnesota Senate District 48 candidate Laurie McKendry are on campaign material identified as independent expenditures approved and paid for by the Minnesota DFL Party. The facts demonstrate a coordination of effort between McKendry, the DFL Senate Caucus and the Minnesota DFL Party. As a result, the expenditures do not qualify as an independent expenditure and should be found to be in violation of Minnesota Statutes, §10A.01. It is requested that the Board provide appropriate relief and penalties as prescribed by law.

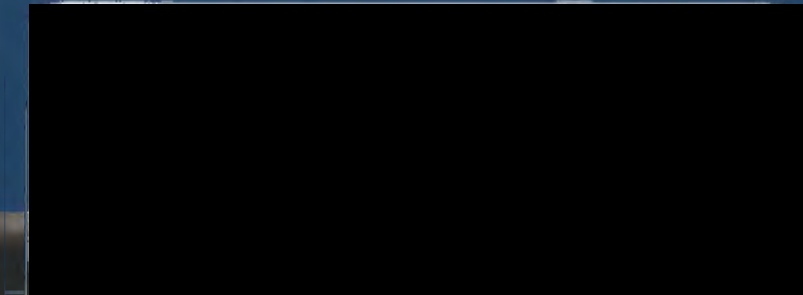

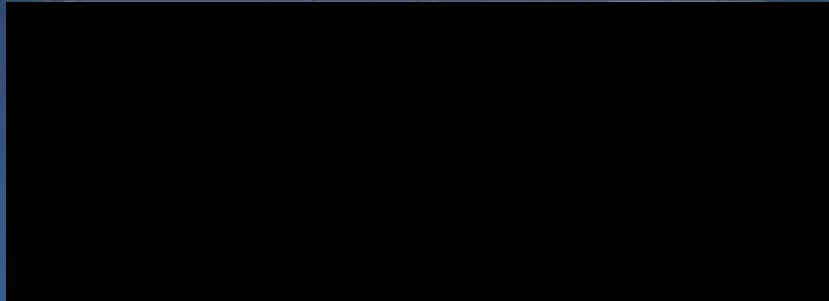

McKendry sees impact of light rail

Sen. David Hann has voted against state funding for the Southwest LRT Project. This places at risk over \$600,000,000 of federal funds for the project. Our state has to compete with other states for these dollars. If Minnesota doesn't receive them, the money isn't saved. It will go to other states where elected officials are more enlightened about the benefits of supporting rail projects — places like Houston and Charlotte. Those cities will use their expanded light rail systems as a tool to attract new businesses.

\$600 million will provide thousands of jobs in the short-term and create significant development opportunities for Eden Prairie and Minnetonka in the long term. Are You Registered to Vote?

Not certain if you're currently registered to vote? Visit this page on the Minnesota Secretary of State's website to check.

Registering to Vote

If you aren't registered to vote, you can still register at your polling location. Here's how:

You must bring one of the following with your current name and address to verify your residence in your precinct:

- a valid Minnesota driver's license, learner's permit, Minnesota ID card or a receipt for any of these
- a valid student ID card including your photo, if your college has provided a student housing list to election officials
- a Tribal ID card that contains your picture and signature
- a valid registration in the same precinct under a different name or address
- a notice of late registration sent to you by your county auditor or city clerk
- a voter registered in the same precinct as you who can confirm your address with a signed oath
- an employee of the residential facility where you live who can confirm your address with a signed oath
- Both a photo ID from the list below and a current bill from the list below with your current name and address in the precinct.

- Minnesota Driver's License
- Minnesota ID Card
- United States Passport
- United States Military ID Card
- Tribal ID Card
- Minnesota University, College or Technical College ID Card

Bills (delivered electronically or by mail)

- TV (cable, satellite, etc.)
- Internet services
- Electric
- Gas
- Solid Waste
- Sewer Services
- Water
- Rent statement dated within 30 days of election day that itemizes utilities
- Current student fee statement

Where do You Vote? What Races Will Be on the Ballot?

With the redistricting that happened earlier this year, you may not be voting in the same location. To check your polling location, visit this page on the Minnesota Secretary of State's website.

When you're taken to the page showing where you will be voting, you will be able to download a list of candidates running for office. You can also download a sample ballot.

Need a Ride to the Polls?

The Rides to the Polls Coalition is a non-partisan project led by multiple non-profits in Minnesota. They are offering free rides to the polls for people who can't get there without help. You will need to reserve your place, so call 1-855-507-4337 or send an e-mail to publicaffairs@couragecenter.org as soon as you can to ensure you have a slot on their list of people to transport to the polls.

Trained volunteer drivers will pick people up, and take them back home. Rides are available from 6:00 am to 8:00 pm. Fully accessible vans are ready to meet the needs of all people, including those using wheelchairs, scooters and walkers.

I will work toward creating a climate where businesses can thrive. This includes tax reform, skills training and partnerships between the private and public sector.

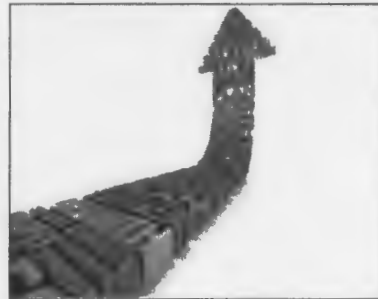
Education

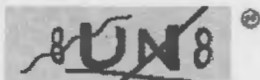

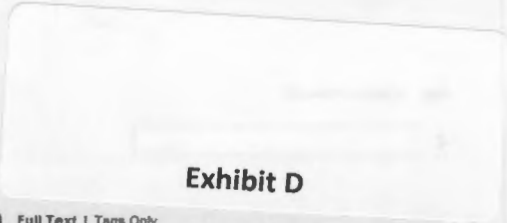
